These graduates will be our next bankers, doctors, lawyers, judges etc. They will go out into society with the knowledge of what they learned. In my experience of visiting schools and telling my orange shirt story - students have empathy, and they really care. I look forward to witnessing the societal change in attitude and behaviour toward Indigenous peoples.

The 2026 Graduating Class events will let Canadians know that change is happening. For Indigenous people, we can look forward to being treated with respect and understanding.

My hope is to have Graduating Class events in the years following 2026 as well, as some did not start their Orange Shirt Day – Every Child Matters events in 2013.

What started as an idea, turned into a dream and now will become reality! I look forward to celebrating the Graduating Class of 2026 with you.
